

OUTSIDE PLANT TECHNICIAN (Ingram TX)

Perform skilled technical duties relating to the installation and maintenance of telecommunications outside plant facilities and services. Install, maintain and service customer premise equipment (CPE). Perform maintenance and provisioning activities regarding access network electronics, rectifiers, batteries, and OSP electronics cabinets.

Essential Job Functions:

Install and maintain services on the telephone / broadband distribution network from the Main Distribution Frame (MDF) or Access Line Concentrator / Digital Services Access Multiplexer (DSLAM) to customer premise. Perform all wiring, testing, activation and maintenance activities required for POTS, XDSL and Networking services. Install and maintain CPE local area networks (LAN) and WiFi networks, including DSL routers and premise Hubs. Install and maintain network interface devices (NID) and Optical Network Terminals (ONT). Perform skilled troubleshooting on both copper and fiber optic cable to the demarcation point and beyond including CPE. Perform tests, provision, and replace access equipment, batteries, rectifiers, other to maintain service at concentrator locations. Operate aerial lift equipped (bucket) company vehicle. Climb poles where vehicle access is unavailable or impractical to the work operation. Utilize face-to-face customer contact to promote / sell Company Services

Experience / Requirements / Education:

High school diploma or equivalent plus five years of experience in Telephony or Networking Installation and Repair. A+ and Net+ certification highly attractive. Basic knowledge of electricity, fiber optic theory, telephone, xDSL and Network installation and maintenance required. Knowledge of industry related test equipment and locating equipment required. Ability to install and troubleshoot CPE devices related to telephone, broadband and internal networks. Ability to operate a computer and use various software programs. Must be a team player, personable, professional, using tact and diplomacy. Must possess excellent verbal and written skills with ability to represent Cooperative to its membership.
