

CABLE SPLICING TECHNICIAN (Ingram TX)

The primary responsibilities of the Cable Splicing Technician will be to splice copper and fiber optic cables in both outdoor and indoor settings. Must be able to read, interpret, create and maintain splicing schematics and diagrams as well as maintain control of outside plant activities surrounding the assigned work site(s). Must also be able to take and maintain accurate splicing and field notes. Performs assigned cutovers and supports project timelines along with inspections and design. Additionally, must provide accurate staking sheets for projects.

Must be able to respond to outside plant emergency calls as needed, including nights and weekends. May require on-call rotation and/or reporting to job on short notice to repair damaged cables until service is restored.

Essential Job Functions:

Ability to properly place copper and fiber terminals on all sizes of cables and properly manage slack, ground cable, and maintain a neat and dressed splice case. Ability to place a mid-sheath splice. Must be able to assist and perform duties of a Construction Lineman/Technician. Ability to test and troubleshoot using a TDR, OTDR, voltmeter, optical power meter and light source, fiber identifier and scope and resolve the problem. Ability to work both trouble and power feeds to sealed units. Must be able to make precise recommendations for changes in assignment routes, or provide input into construction methodologies. Commits to performing job tasks in a manner that ensures a safe working environment.

Experience / Requirements / Education:

High school diploma, or equivalent, plus two years of experience in lineman, construction or outside plant installation. Must have a valid Class A Texas Commercial Driver's License. Pole Climbing Certification required (or ability to attain within six months from date of hire). Knowledge in telephone line construction, RUS practices and standards, and telecommunications plant operations and maintenance a must. Must have extensive skills sets in operation of various vehicles and construction equipment; and, reading of specification sheets, staking sheets and cable records.

Selected applicant will be required to pass pre-employment background check, motor vehicle check and drug test (including drug and alcohol verification from previous employers for the past 3 years).
